When trying to an audio download a file it may, by default, open in the browser window and not download to your computer.

To remedy this problem, find your browser type below and follow the steps:

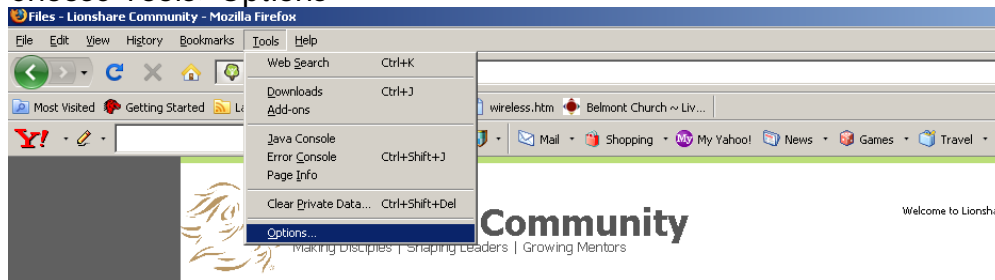

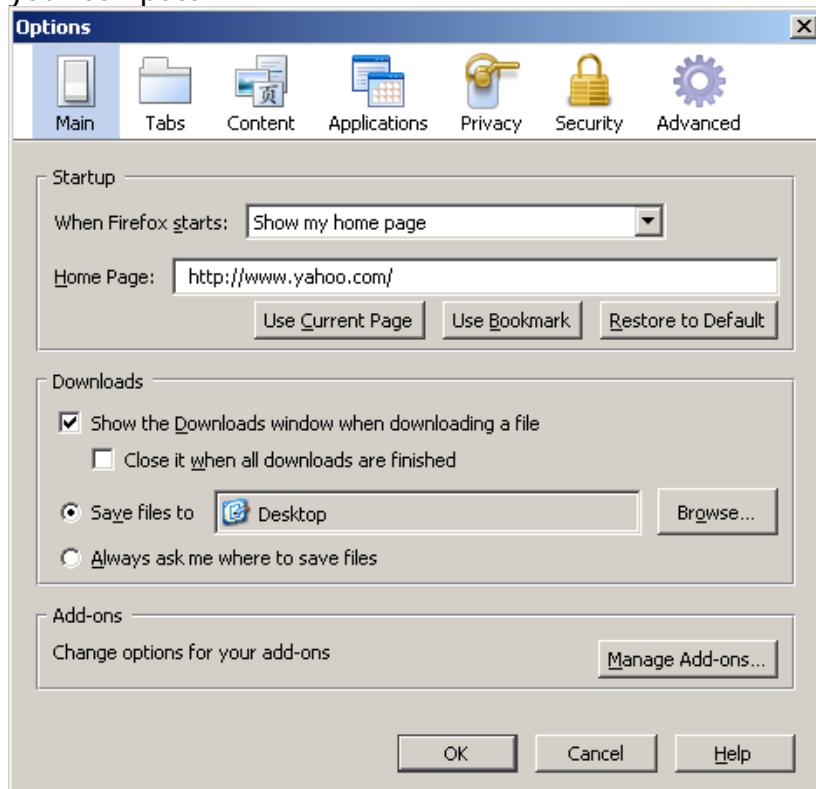
Mozilla Firefox: Version 3.x

(to determine the version go to Help>About)

Choose Tools>Options



On the Main Tab – look in the Downloads section – this is where the files will be downloaded to your computer



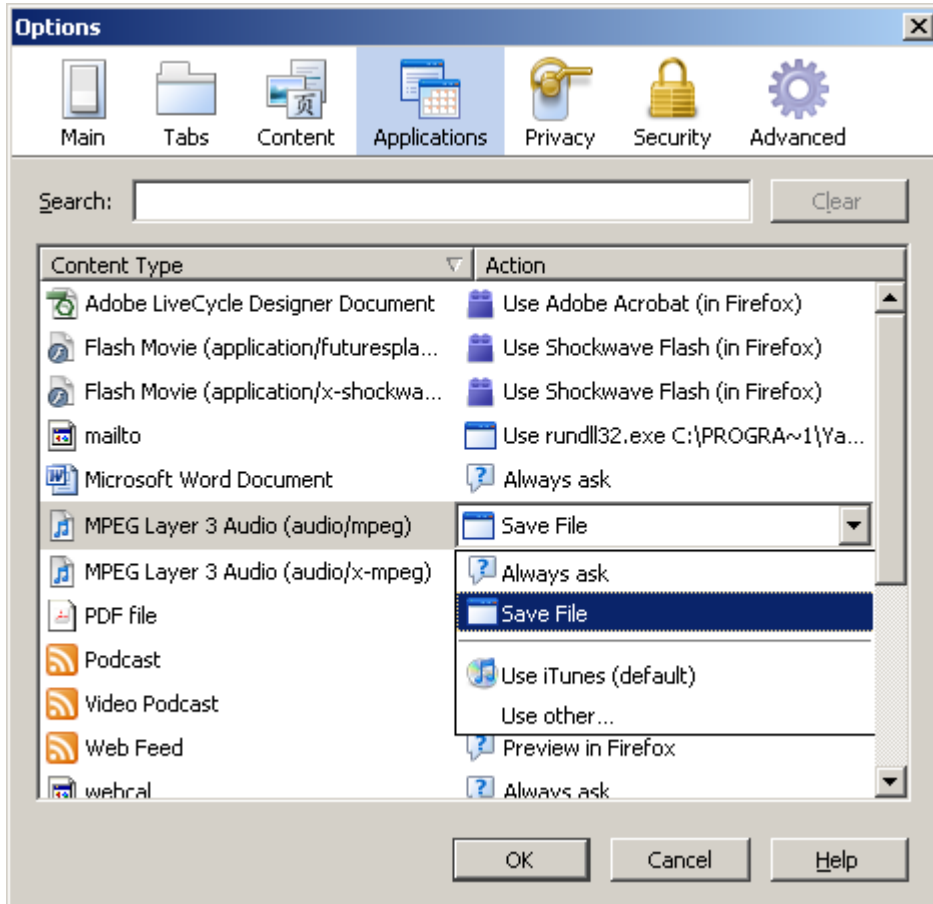
Click on the Applications Tab

View the MPEG Layer 3 Audio (audio/mpeg)

This is what defines what happens when clicking on a mp3 download.

Change this to Save File or Always Ask.

Now, when you click on the Download button, you will be prompted to save the MP3 file to your computer.

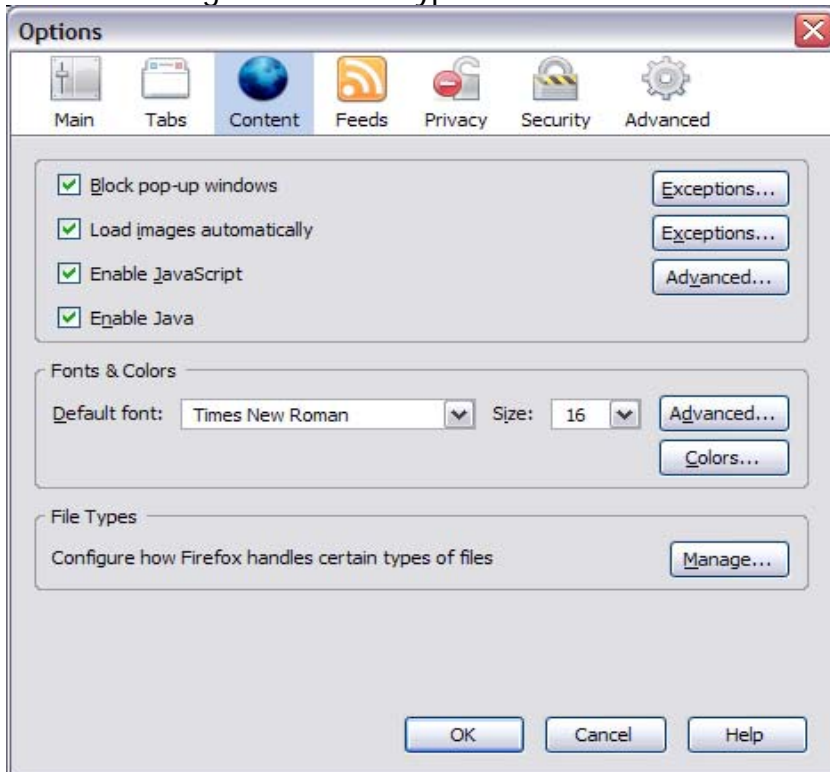




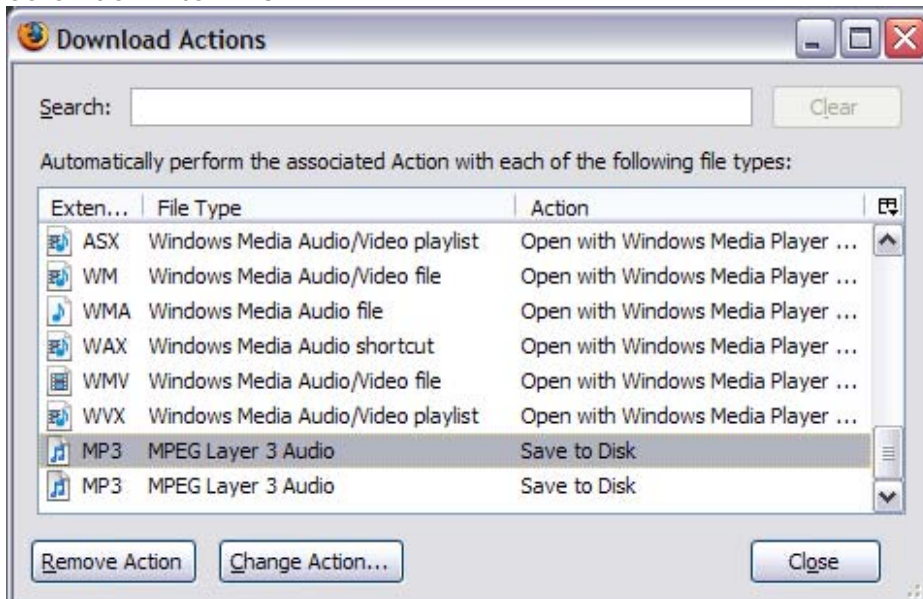
Mozilla Firefox: Version 2.x

(to determine the version go to Help>About)

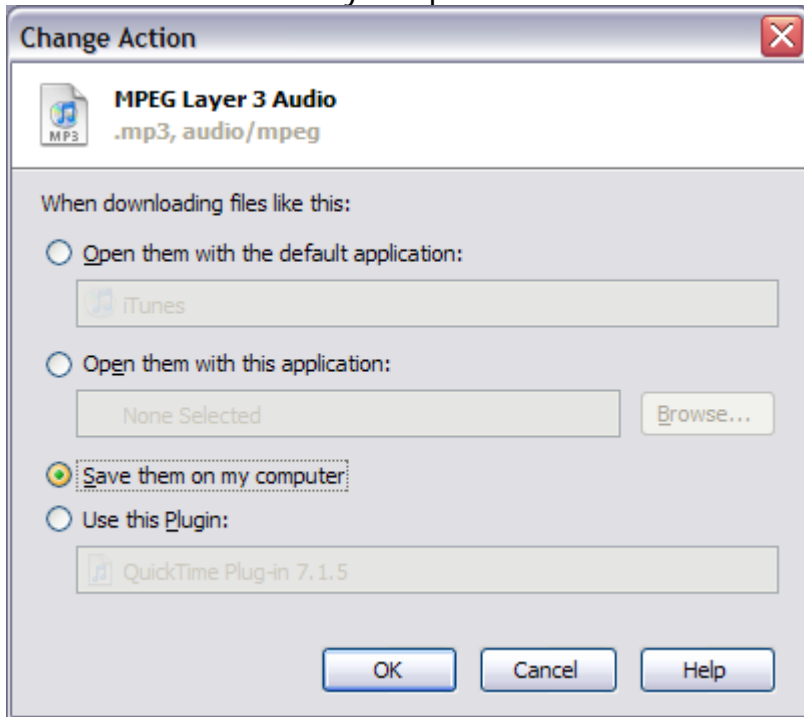
Open Firefox
Choose Tools>Options
Click on Content
Click on Manage under File Types



Scroll down to MP3



Click on Change Action
Choose Save them to my computer:



Now, when you click on the Download button, you will be prompted to save the MP3 file to your computer.



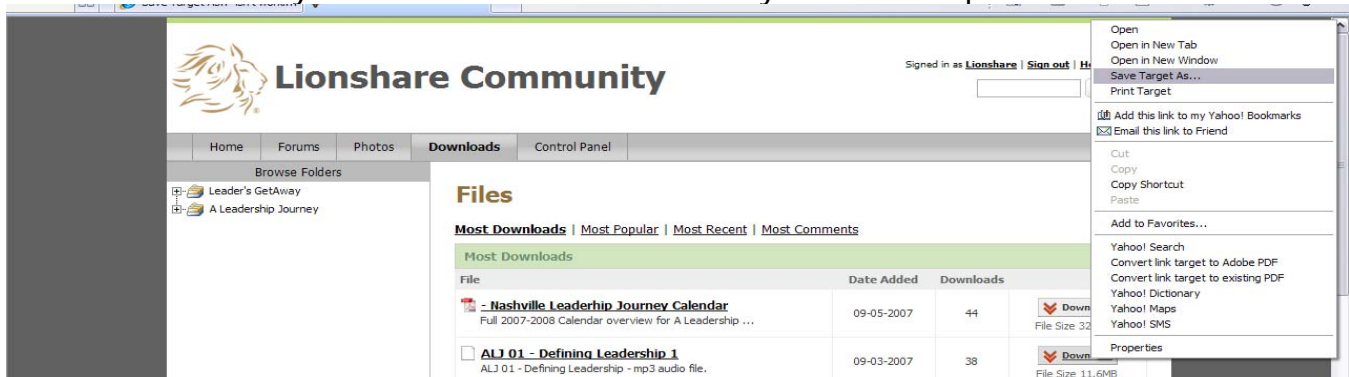
Safari Instructions

Press Option and click on Download will automatically download the file to your computer (desktop by default)



Internet Explorer 7.0

Right click on the Download button and choose Save Target As.
Then choose where you want the file to be saved on your local computer.



Importing into iTunes

Once the file is downloaded, to import the file into iTunes, open iTunes.

File> Import

Find the file and choose Import. You can then copy the file over to your iPod. These instructions should apply for any media player although the steps may vary depending on the software.
